- Frances Friedman Scholarship (\$225.00) - Given to the best essay by a 4th or 5th grade boy.
- Ellen M. Brundige Scholarship (\$225.00) - Given to the best essay by a 6th, 7th, or 8th grade girl.
- Ann and Winston Brundige Scholarship (\$225.00) - Given to the best essay by a 6th, 7th, or 8th grade boy.

Essay Topics

- Why should America send astronauts to the Moon and then to Mars?
- Why should America send astronauts to the Moon but not to Mars?
- Why should America not send astronauts to the Moon or to Mars?

Essay Guidelines

- Those students who received a persuasive essay scholarship last summer are not eligible this year.
- Essays must be received by April 30, 2010.
- Essays must be two pages (excluding cover sheet), typed, and double spaced.
- Essays must be in a 12 pt Times New Roman font.
- Essay must include a cover sheet which includes the following;
 - Essay Topic
 - Students Name
 - School
 - Grade
 - Teacher
 - Sex (Boy or Girl)

- Essays which do not meet the listed guidelines will be disqualified.

Important Information(please read carefully)

- A scholarship committee consisting of parents and teachers will read and evaluate all entries.
- The committee will decide who receives the scholarships no later than May 12, 2010.
- The scholarship committee members will know only the grade and sex of the essay writer. All other information such as name, school, and teacher will be withheld.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified via their teachers no later than May 14, 2010.
- Scholarships can only be used toward Astro Camp's summer programs.
- Two spots will be held in the Voyager Camp (July 13-16) for the 4th and 5th grade winners. Two spots will be held in the Astronaut Training Camp (June 22-25) for the 6th, 7th, or 8th grade winners. Students use their scholarships toward other camps but are subject to the availability of that camp at the time they were notified as a scholarship winner.
- Scholarships cannot be used for Cadet Camp.
- The remaining camp tuition above the \$225.00 award must be paid by the recipient, parents, or family members no later than June 1, 2010.
- Students must meet age and experience requirements, if any, for the summer camp they would like to attend. These requirements can be found on the summer camp application form which is available on the website (www.astrocamputah.org).
- Essays will not be returned. Students must make additional copies should they like to keep a copy for themselves.
